**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LONG BEACH, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING A SETTLEMENT IN THE MATTER OF JAMES HEATLEY V. TOWNSHIP OF LONG BEACH, ET AL., DOCKET NO. OCN-L-463-13**

**WHEREAS**, James Heatley has filed a lawsuit against in the Superior Court of New Jersey, Law Division, Ocean County entitled Heatley v. Township of Long Beach, Ralph Bayard, Mark Shields, Dana Vickers, Robert Pinto, Michael Ott, and Ryan Keller; under Docket No. OCN-L-463-13; and

**WHEREAS**, James Heatley has, in addition to filing the aforementioned lawsuit in the Law Division, filed a petition in the Workers Compensation Court of New Jersey entitled, James Heatley v. Long Beach Township, C.P. No. 2012-25834; and

**WHEREAS**, James Heatley and the Township of Long Beach and all named defendants, are desirous of amicably resolving the above matters.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the governing body of the Township of Long Beach, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey as follows:

1. James Heatley shall be paid and he shall accept the sum of \$75,000.00 as complete and total satisfaction of any and all claims, including counsel fees that are set forth in the matter of Heatley v. Township of Long Beach, under Docket No. OCN-L-463-13, et al.
2. The sum of \$75,000.00 shall be paid as follows:
  - a. \$60,000.00 shall be paid by the insurance carrier for the Township of Long Beach.
  - b. \$15,000.00 shall be paid by the Township of Long Beach.
3. The settlement and payment of \$75,000.00 is explicitly contingent upon the insurance carrier paying the sum of \$60,000.00 towards the settlement.
4. The Township of Long Beach has agreed to pay the cost for mediation in the amount of \$1,600.00. The said sum of \$1,600.00 shall be paid as follows:
  - a. \$320.00 to be paid by the Township of Long Beach;
  - b. \$1,280.00 to be paid by the Insurance Carrier for the Township of Long Beach
  - c. The payment of \$1,600.00 is explicitly contingent upon the insurance carrier paying the sum of \$1,280.00 toward the costs.
5. With regards to the Workers Compensation matter, James Heatley has agreed to accept the sum of \$27,500.00 as complete and total satisfaction and release of that matter. James Heatley has agreed that the said sum of \$27,500.00 shall be paid under Section 20 settlement and from the amount the TDB lien of \$1,927.41 shall be deducted and paid to the State of New Jersey as well as customary attorney fees and costs.
6. The said sum of \$27,500.00 shall be paid by the Municipal Joint Insurance Fund through its Workers Compensation coverage for the Township of Long Beach.
7. The Ocean County Joint Insurance Fund shall pay to the plaintiff's attorney, Carolyne Kalson, a sum not to exceed \$2,000.00 for motion practice participated in by Carolyne Kalson in the Workers Compensation Court. The amount of said fee shall be determined by the Workers Compensation Court.
8. James Heatley shall be entitled to continue to receive medical treatment paid through the Ocean County Joint Insurance Fund to November 1, 2015 or until MMI, if sooner.
9. The payments to be paid by the Ocean County Joint Insurance Fund are subject to approval by the Joint Insurance Fund and this agreement to pay same is also contingent upon the Fund approving the payments.
10. It is further understood and agreed that the payment of the money being paid is in full accord and satisfaction, and in compromise of, any and all disputed claims, and that the payment of the money is not an admission of liability but is made for the sole purpose of terminating the litigation between the parties.
