## ADOPTING THE STATE AFFORDABLE HOUSING CALCULATIONS AND AUTHORIZING THE REQUIRED LITIGATION

which the judiciary reviews and grants a certification of compliance pursuant to the Fair Housing Act, N.J.S.A. 52:27D-301 et seq., for municipalities adopting housing element and fair share plans that include the constitutional obligation to create realistic opportunities low- and moderate-income households; and WHEREAS, by way of P.L. 2024, c. 2, the State of New Jersey has created the "Affordable Housing Dispute Resolution Program" (the "Program") within the judiciary through

declaratory judgment through the Program; and WHEREAS, the Township of Long Beach (the "Township") intends to preserve its ability to seek a certification of compliance pursuant to the Fair Housing Act, by formally determining and calculating its present and prospective need, and authorizing the filing of a

WHEREAS, the Township has reviewed the calculations prepared by the Department of Community Affairs for the period from 2025 to 2035, which determined that the Township has a present need of 0 units and a prospective need of 47 units; and WHEREAS, the

prospective need for low- and moderate-income households thereunder appear to conform to the standards established under the Fair Housing Act, and wishes to accept these calculations; and WHEREAS, the Township has determined that the calculations of present and

and WHEREAS, the Township is located entirely within an environmentally constrained area, due to its location on a barrier island located within the flood zones, and the Township anticipates relying upon a vacant land adjustment as part of its mechanisms of compliance;

**WHEREAS**, the Township adopts this binding resolution, pursuant to the Fair Housing Act, committing to the adoption of a housing element and fair share plan within the timelines established by the Fair Housing Act.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, in accordance with the foregoing recitals, which are incorporated herein, by the Township of Long Beach as follows.

- The Township has determined that its present need obligation for affordable housing during the period from 2025 to 2035 is 0 units.
- 5 The Township has determined that its prospective need obligation for affordable housing during the period from 2025 to 2035 is 47 units.
